RESOLUTION NUMBER 2021-001

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE DIVISION OF THE
TOWN OF MARSHFIELD INTO TWO WARDS

WHEREAS, municipalities are required to establish wards in accordance with Section 5.15 of the Wisconsin Statutes following the issuance of a federal decennial census, and

WHEREAS, said decennial census has been issued and the municipality has received a tentative supervisory district plan from Fond du Lac County, and municipalities are required to make a good faith effort to accommodate the tentative plan submitted by the county.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Town of Marshfield that there shall be two wards, the municipal boundaries of which are established as follows:

Ward 1 containing a 2020 population of 497 and comprising the part of tentative supervisory district number 12.

A description of the boundaries of Ward 1, consistent with the conventions set forth in Section 4.003 of the Wisconsin Statutes, is set forth as follows: South of County Road Q, West of Oak Road, South of County Road WH, West of Walnut Road, West of County Road CCC, West of Triple T Road and then bound by the Town of Marshfield municipal boundary on the South and West.

Ward 2 containing a 2020 population of 626 and comprising the part of tentative supervisory district number 12.


A description of the boundaries of Ward 2, consistent with the conventions set forth in Section 4.003 of the Wisconsin Statutes, is set forth as follows: North of County Road Q, East of Oak Road, North of County Road WH, East of Walnut Road, East of County Road CCC, East of Triple T Road and then bound by the Town of Marshfield municipal boundary on the South, East and North.

The polling place for Wards 1 and 2 is hereby designated as follows: Town Hall, 999 Fond du Lac Street, Mt. Calvary, WI 53057.

That there will be no changes for voting at Elections, all residents will vote as one ward.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that there is attached to and made a part of this resolution a map of the Town of Marshfield, which illustrates the revised boundaries of the above-listed wards.
